GUIDED TOURS

Walk Historic Wethersfield

Learn about the major sites, events and people connected with the town's rich history. One mile; 90 minutes; \$5 adults; children free

Burying Ground Tour

Tour the Ancient Burying Ground & learn about early burial customs, gravestone art and its occupants. Ninety minutes; uneven ground; \$5 adults; children free

Colonial Revival Walking Tour

Explore the village's 20th century neighborhoods, noting how owners adapted their "modern" houses to the architecture of the Colonial Revival. One and a half miles; ninety minutes; \$5; children free
